Cass Sculpture Foundation – Goodwood, Chichester – www.sculpture.org.uk

The Cass Sculpture Foundation is a charity, recognised internationally as the home of 21st century British sculpture. The charity's key objective is to enable the future of British sculpture today. Over the past 15 years, we have commissioned more than 160 large-scale sculptures from over 120 British artists.

Cass Sculpture Foundation commissions several new large-scale sculptures each year, funded by the sale of previously commissioned works. By doing so, the Foundation continues to provide support and promotion for contemporary British sculpture as well as a unique aesthetic experience for its many visitors.

Galereya opened in 1999, the idea of Evelina Lee – a Russian artist, Robin Mitchell and Kevin Sullivan. The purpose of this gallery is to support new Russian artists who are graduates of the Moscow Institute of Fine Art and St Petersburg Fine Art Academy and to introduce them to the British public.

Havant Art Centre has a broad programme of entertainment including theatre shows, music, comedy nights, films, dance events, exhibitions and workshops. In addition, it has an on-site licensed restaurant – Red Mango - that provides lunches and buffets for conferences. It is also available for hire for meetings, classes, birthday parties and shows. Havant Arts Centre sister venue is Bedhampton Arts Centre which is home to Making Space and SCAT Theatre Company.

Bosham Walk Art & Craft Centre is situated in the picturesque village of Old Bosham . The Craft Centre has 17 small shops of individual crafts on two floors. The ground floor is similar to an old style shopping street with flag stone floors, there are olde world wooden beams and the shops are finished in keeping with the surroundings. On this floor also, are glass cabinets with many more interesting crafts displayed.

There are many more shops on the first floor and a light and airy gallery with a variety of paintings by local artists. Many of the shops are working studios where the artists and crafts people are happy to discuss what they are making.

The Otter Gallery, University of Chichester

The Otter Gallery is supported by the University to provide an artistic service to its students and to the people of Chichester and the surrounding region. The original gallery was established in 1990 as part of the 150th anniversary celebrations. The present dedicated Gallery, in the Learning Resources Centre, was opened by Lord Dearing in 1998. The Gallery offers visitors a series of contrasting exhibitions in different media throughout the year. An emphasis is placed on giving young artists an opportunity to show their work. The Gallery welcomes proposals from artists for new exhibitions.

The Gallery also has a distinguished collection of 20th century British art, which complements the exhibition programme. It includes works by artists such as Henry Moore, Patrick Heron, Stanley Spencer and Graham Sutherland.

The Oxmarket Centre of Arts, Chichester – www.oxmarket.com

The Centre of Arts is located in the old church of St Andrew-in –Oxmarket, Chichester and Centre's core activity provides six exhibition spaces and with the main emphasis on the visual arts, creates varied opportunities for the local and regional community to participate in and enjoy arts-related events.
